


In 1983, Northamptonshire Police set up a Neighbourhood Watch scheme which was seen as one of the first in the country. Five years later, in 1988,

Supporting Coordinators with promotion of crime reduction and building resilience	Building your network, supporting existing and developing new Coordinators
Signpost to know where to go for Crime Prevention advice – website, local policing, council	Encourage Coordinators to join Knowledge Hub to have access to training and support for their roles
Signpost how and who to report safety concerns	Maintain regular contact with Coordinators and support them with training opportunities
Support Coordinators to identify areas of higher risk and encourage community action	Build local networking and support with partners, local groups, and businesses
Support Coordinators to encourage Coordinators to report suspicious activity, antisocial behaviour and incidents to police and local authorities	Attend local events, with partners when appropriate. I.e., Police Bike marking, Drop in events
Support Coordinators to be involved in Ward/ Safer Neighbourhood panels to support local police and other agencies to identify local issues and solve problems where there are community concerns	Support Coordinators to hold community events – such as <u>street</u> <u>parties</u> , picnics, sports day, community safety events, <u>listening</u> <u>events</u> etc

Helpful tips

Set up a generic email for the role – e.g., <u>Great Yarmouth AreaNW@gmail.com</u>, one that can be passed on if you leave the role,

so that there is continuity for the role

Get connected on the Knowledge Hub

Use the OurWatchMember/Alert platform to communicate with Coordinators

Have regular meetings with local police to keep each other up to date with crime trends, events etc

Represent your area to your Force Area Association and work with them to access resources and support

1. Name of the Organisation

Rev - 03

1.1 — The name of the organisation is "Northamptonshire Neighbourhood Watch Association" (hereinafter referred to as 'the Association'.

1.2 The Association shall be an unincorporated, not for profit organisation, without political affiliation, non-sectarian in religion, operating an equal opportunities and non-discriminatory policy and will embrace and encourage diversity.

2. Objectives of the Organisation

2.1 To assist with the continued development and support of Neighbourhood Watch Association and Groups located across Northamptonshire, to promote good citizenship and greater public awareness, increase public participation in the prevention and detection of crime, reduce the fear of crime, improve police/community liaison and increase community safety in partnership with recognised Authorities and with other relevant organisations.

3. Powers

In furtherance of the identified Objectives, the Association will strive to:

3.1 Promote and assist in the development of Neighbourhood Watch Associations and Groups across Northamptonshire and participate in the wider promotion of Neighbourhood Watch more generally.

3.2 Carry out research and surveys, provide and communicate information, services and advice to and on behalf of all Association Members, exchange information and share and promote best effective practices. Additionally promote acceptable behaviour and performance standards amongst all Neighbourhood Watch entities and, where appropriate, with other organisations. Provide relevant, accurate and timely information to the public and media in the appropriate context and circumstances, whils theing always within the approved guidelines.

NNW ASSOCIATION CONSTITUTION

Proposed – Alan Earle Seconded Andy Crisp Majority in favour

1. Safeguarding Policy

1.1 Northamptonshire NHW Association (NNWA) commits to protect the welfare of all children and vulnerable adults with whom it comes into contact with, or who are involved in Neighbourhood Watch activity, to ensure that they are welcomed into a safe, caring environment, with a happy and friendly atmosphere.

1.2 Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility. NNWA recognises that it is the responsibility of each one of its Officers, Members and Volunteers to prevent the neglect, physical, sexual or emotional abuse of children and vulnerable adults and to report any suspected abuse.

2. Scope

This policy and procedure outlines the specific responsibilities of NNWA Officers, Members and Volunteers to safeguard children and vulnerable adults and to promote their welfare.
 Any reference to Northants NWA includes NNW Association members, NHW area and street co-ordinators and any other persons aligned to the County Neighbourhood Watch Network, or having a role supporting Neighbourhood Watch activity in any capacity within Northamptonshire.
 Any reference to NNWA members also includes Association Personnel whilst engaged with work related to NNWA, including but not limited to consultants, contractors, journalists, celebrities and politicians who may, upon occasion, visit NNWA events and locations.

3. Safeguarding Lead

3.1 The appointed Safeguarding Lead (by default) is the elected NNWA Chairperson.

3.2 Members must immediately report any issue arising from this policy to the Safeguarding Lead who will review and ensure that any issue is raised with the relevant statutory authority and a record is issued to the NNWA Executive Committee, as soon as is practicable.

4. Neighbourhood Watch Associations

4.1 District NNW Associations that are not entities in their own right must abide by this policy and procedure and advise the NNWA Safeguarding Lead when they have reported safeguarding concerns about a child or a vulnerable adult to their local Children's or Adult Social Care Team or to the local Police.

4.2 Where District Associations elect to be registered charities, they are expected to adopt this policy and have their own Safeguarding Lead and similar procedures in place to safeguard children and vulnerable adults.

5. Reporting Concerns to Children's Social Care

5.1 It is important that NNWA Officers, Members and Volunteers report safeguarding concerns to Children's or Adult Social Care and / or their local Police force immediately they become aware.
