- 1. I have been clerk of the Hemington, Luddington and Thurning Parish Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") since the 20.
- 2. The piece of land to which this Statutory Declaration refers to is shown edged red on the plan attached hereto marked "RA 1" and is known as the Thurning Weir (hereinafter referred to as the "the Pocket Park").
- 3. For many years past the Council set aside funds to dredge The Pocket Park. Enclosed is an income and expenditure for the years 2011 to 2012 attached hereto marked "RA 2".
- 4. The Council added the Pocket Park to a list of areas where dog fouling penalties could be enforced. Please see a copy of a meeting dated the 29th March 2007 attached hereto marked "RA 3".
- 5. An example of the well-being of the Pocket Park can be found in the Agenda of the Annual Parish meeting dated 11th May 2010 and a subsequent minute attached hereto marked "RA 4".
- 6. A motion to apply for possessory title was debated by the Council at a meeting of the 12th January 2012. The minute is attached hereto marked "RA 5".
- 7. Since then, the Council have itemised the Pocket Park individually at their annual Parish meeting and have also in their accounts individually itemised any Pocket Park funds.
- 8. Throughout this time, I believe the Council has been in continuous full free and undisturbed possession and enjoyment of the Pocket Park to the exclusion of all others without giving any acknowledgement of the title of any other person to it or any part of it and without the consent of any such person and without any claim adverse to its title to the Pocket Park.
- 9. The facts stated in this declaration are in my own knowledge.
